Pastor Alfred and AnnMarie Ogbumor have been called into the ministry to proclaim the Gospel of the Kingdom of God. On December 23rd 2003, the name of the ministry "One Flock One Shepherd Ministries" was born from John 10:16.

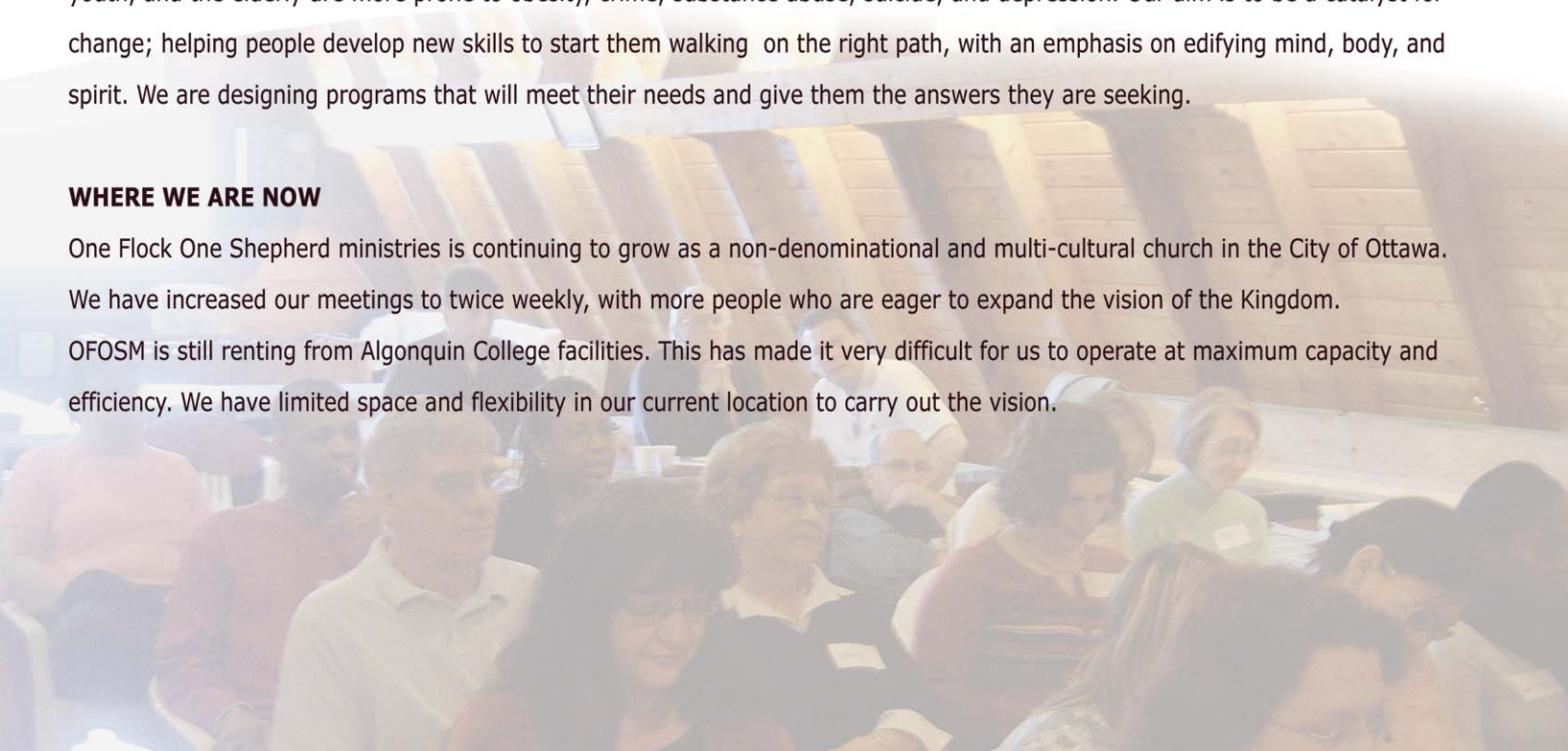
Pastor Alfred was led to incorporate the ministry in 2006 with five people as board of directors. The ministry began with renting facilities at Algonquin College Ottawa with just a few members. However, God kept reminding us not to forget the vision according to His word from the book of Zechariah 4:8-10;

"8 Moreover the word of the LORD came to me, saying: 9 "The hands of Zerubbabel Have laid the foundation of this temple; His hands shall also finish it. Then you will know that the LORD of hosts has sent me to you. 10 For who has despised the day of small things? For these seven rejoice to see the plumb line in the hand of Zerubbabel. They are the eyes of the LORD, Which scan to and fro throughout the whole earth."

In addition to a sanctuary, OFOSM's desire is to incorporate a community center into it's facility. Our ultimate goal is to encourage people to live in their fullest potential. Research has shown that due to lack of focus, direction and activity, children, youth, and the elderly are more prone to obesity, crime, substance abuse, suicide, and depression. Our aim is to be a catalyst for change; helping people develop new skills to start them walking on the right path, with an emphasis on edifying mind, body, and spirit. We are designing programs that will meet their needs and give them the answers they are seeking.

WHERE WE ARE NOW

One Flock One Shepherd ministries is continuing to grow as a non-denominational and multi-cultural church in the City of Ottawa. We have increased our meetings to twice weekly, with more people who are eager to expand the vision of the Kingdom. OFOSM is still renting from Algonquin College facilities. This has made it very difficult for us to operate at maximum capacity and efficiency. We have limited space and flexibility in our current location to carry out the vision.

≈ Day care & School

There is a growing need for child care in Ottawa and its surroundings.

Our plan for a day care center is to help working parents as well as to help educate and teach children the love of God.

We will provide a learning center that is a safe, clean, stimulating and child friendly environment. Our day care learning center will cater to young infants straight through to children of high school ages.

Our day care learning center will work towards obtaining subsidies from the Government to assist low income families to obtain quality education for their children.





~ What We Need

To meet our goals of operating both a community center and a place of worship we will need a minimum of 3 acres of land in the City of Ottawa. Based on our research, 3 acres of land will cost approximately \$1.1 million.

The building and materials will cost approximately \$2.9 million. An additional \$500,000.00 will go towards the operation of our community services . We are looking for \$4.5 million dollars to complete our project.

This project will be completed in three separate stages.

PHASE 1

Cost: 1.2 million

Duration: 6-8 months

Plan:

Begin operation of select community services through our current existing facilities.

The primary services including; Seniors services, men and women's support groups, youth services such as homework clubs etc..

Purchase 3 acres of land

PHASE 2

Cost: 2.8 million

Duration: 1 year 6 months

Plan:

Begin construction of Sanctuary which will seat approximately 300 to 500 people

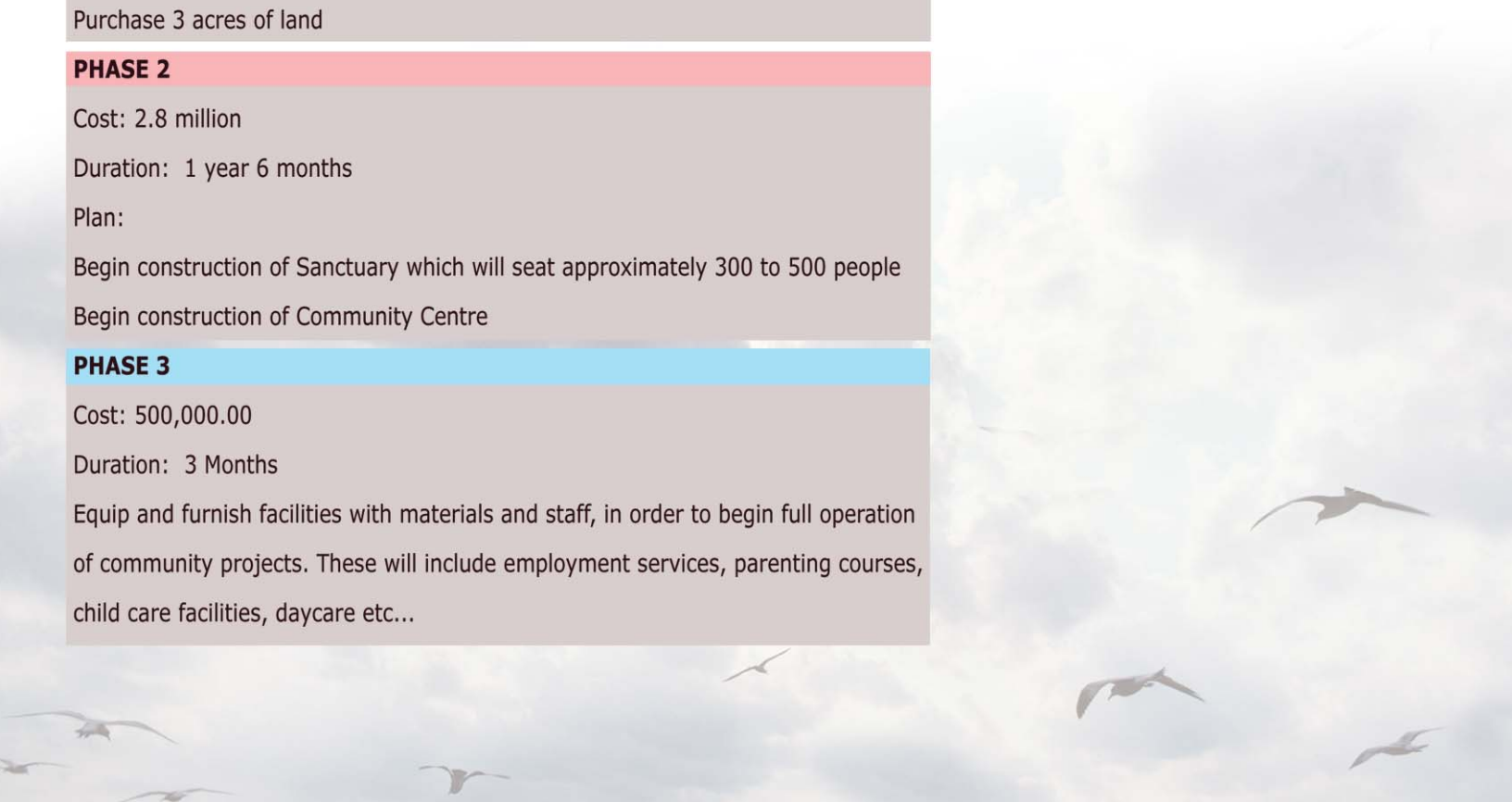
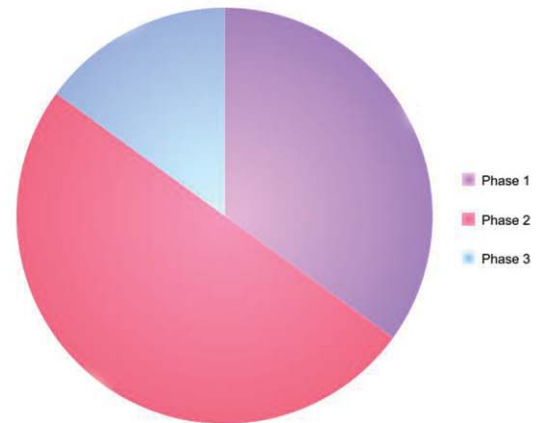
Begin construction of Community Centre

PHASE 3

Cost: 500,000.00

Duration: 3 Months

Equip and furnish facilities with materials and staff, in order to begin full operation of community projects. These will include employment services, parenting courses, child care facilities, daycare etc...
